Notes from Mia Klein:

This Bressler starts out with darker aromas of cacao dusted chocolate truffle, molasses, cigar box, coffee bean, and plum, then moves to raspberry, dried violet, sandalwood, and just a hint of vanilla bean. Flavors in the mouth mirror the aromatic expression almost perfectly due to the balance of extract and body. Quite rare (and quite a treat!) to taste all these flavors so clearly in a young Cabernet. When the flavors are this generous at this stage, it's part of the wine's DNA, and you can expect more of the same 1, 2, 5,10, and 15+ years from now.
